First Candle: Hope for Peace

Isaiah 2:2-4; 9:2, 6-7

One: We light this candle for peace.

All: As wars continue on this earth we acknowledge that Jesus came to show us the way of peace.

One: The Messiah will establish and uphold justice and righteous.

All: We will bring light into the night by transforming our weapons into tools for nurture and peace.

Second Candle: Hope for Healing

Luke 1:46-55

One: We light the second candle for Healing. We regret the brokenness in human relationships, including with indigenous peoples, those who believe differently than us and with creation.

All: Healer of our every ill, may we live for healing and reconciliation

One: Creator, who brings new life to the weak and lowly, we confess our need for healing and wholeness.

All: Healer of our every ill, light of each tomorrow, we welcome you as Mary did. We set aside our fears and welcome your transformative healing. Let it be so.

Third Candle: Hope for Harmony

Isaiah 11:1-10

One: The third candle is lit so that we may see God's passion for harmony.

All: God desires that all live as equals, that no one has power over another, and that no one is abused.

One: We are given the vision of the predator and prey dwelling together, where all are safe in God's domain.

All: Let us hold fast to these visions that they may help us live lives of harmony--harmony in the world and harmony within ourselves.

Fourth Candle: Hope for Love

John 1:1-5, 9-14; 3:16, 17

One: God's love for us is truly the light of the world.

All: We celebrate the good news, which breaks the power of oppression and lifts up the lowly.

One: Lighting this candle is a declaration that light breaks into darkness, that love is stronger than evil.

All: God loves us. God is reaching out to us with love. God gives us love to love each other. Let it be so.

Choir & congregation: STS (purple) #19 "Jesus, Jesus, oh,..."
