

**Situation**

- wide age spectrum
- needed more chairs; good turn out.
- all attentive and low key.
- table groups were homogeneous

**First presentation and discussion**

- \*Key theme “Gender equity” should have been emphasized more.
- discussion time was too short for such a broad question.
- people hesitant to discuss.

**Continued presentation with videos**

- \*Man box – good warning about not valuing gender equality and having respect, yet much too negative about masculinity.
- more negative messaging about masculinity
- good to be aware about how macho training hurts women, yet....
- did not address innate traits of testosterone, and how that affects many people
- was pointed out to avoid shaming, yet rejecting traditional masculine traits does shame.
  
- animated table discussions
- heard men declare how they possessed feminine traits and were embarrassed by masculine ones.
- reminded me of 1980’s male bashing
- most men agreed with “man box”—that they were conditioned.
- much laughter at tables
- some did not share at their table. ??
- we need to keep in mind that we are an enlightened, educated group.
- good to hear that this is much more than a gender issue.
