Matthew 10:34-42 NRSV (New Revised Standard Version)

- ³⁴ "Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth; I have not come to bring peace, but a sword.
 - For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law;
 and one's foes will be members of one's own household.
- Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; ³⁸ and whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me. ³⁹ Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it.
- Whoever welcomes you welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. ⁴¹ Whoever welcomes a prophet in the name of a prophet will receive a prophet's reward; and whoever welcomes a righteous person in the name of a righteous person will receive the reward of the righteous; ⁴² and whoever gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones in the name of a disciple—truly I tell you, none of these will lose their reward."
