Job Description: The Mission, Peace and Justice Coordinator will:

- promote a vision for mission, peace and justice by resourcing new and existing projects, activities and relationship building opportunities; existing high priority projects include Indigenous relations, land stewardship, climate action
- educate and nurture with all ages in the congregation – children and youth included – a faith that embodies mission, peace and justice by having an ongoing Sunday morning presence, participating in worship and faith formation and other aspects of congregational life;
- collaborate with church groups, other faith groups and agencies to identify possible outreach opportunities, with a special attention to our local community.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will have:

- a commitment to and passion for Anabaptist faith-based ministry focused on mission, peace and justice and how these ministries inform all parts of congregational life;
- post secondary degree or diploma preferred, with courses in a relevant field ;
- leadership experience with demonstrated ability to work effectively on a team; enthusiasm and calling to equip, energize and inspire congregants;
- a proven track record of communicating with persons who may hold diverse perspectives;
- good time management
